TOUR PLAN

DAY 01

Amman

Welcome to Amman, Capital of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. Arriving at Queen Alia Airport, meet & assist through all formalities, Dinner & overnight stay in **Amman.**

DAY 02

Petra, Moab, Pisgah

After breakfast proceed to Madaba (the city of Mosaics) Mount Nebo, ten minutes west of Madaba, the final station in the life of the prophet Moses, the Jordan Valley and the hills of Jerusalem – Moses viewed the Promised Land that he would never enter. Visit Petra. (Numbers 20:18–21, 2 Chronicles 20, 1 Samuel 14:47, 2 Samuel 8:13–14) **Overnight stay in Amman.**

Day 03

After breakfast proceed to the Holy Land welcomed by our guide at the border. Proceed to Nazareth Church of the Annunciation, Mary's House, and St. Joseph's Workshop. Visit to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle of changing water into wine. Visit Nazareth village. Overnight stay in Nazareth/Tiberius.

Day 04

After breakfast visit Mount of Beatitude were Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount, continue to Capernaum where we visit Jesus synagogue and the House of St. Peter. Proceed to the Primacy of Peter, where Jesus appeared to his disciples after the Resurrection and where he performed the miraculous catch of the 153 fish and conferred Church authority upon Peter, continue on to Tabgha, the traditional site of the multiplication of loaves and fish followed by a boat ride on the sea of Galilee. Proceed to Mount Tabor and Neim. Overnight stay in Nazareth/Tiberius.

DAY 05:

Mount Carmel-Haifa-Jaffa –Tel Aviv-Jerusalem

After breakfast visit includes Mt. Carmel, Muhrakka and Elijah's Cave, Haifa, We will be driving through Acre and visiting Ceaseria . Drive along the coastal road to visit the old city of Jaffa (Joppa) and see the Church dedicated to St.Peter commemorating his miraculous healing of Tabita. Travel via Tel Aviv to Jerusalem, Visit to Bethany, the house of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. We end the day with visit to the Western Wailing Wall considered to be the holiest site for the Jews. Overnight stay in hotel.

DAY 06:

Mount of Olives - Gethsemane-Bethlehem

After breakfast Visit Mount of Olives and visit the Church of ascension, the church of Peter Noster, descend to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane, the traditional House of Caipas where Peter denied Jesus thrice and where Jesus was kept in the dungeon.

Proceed to Bethlehem the Shepherd's Field and the Church of Nativity, the Birth Place of the Lord Jesus, Visit St. Jeromes Grotto where the Bible was translated from Hebrew. Then visit Jericho Temptation mount

Then proceed to Baptism site of Jesus at Jericho side, Jacobs Well, Shiloh, Beit El (Bethel). Dinner and Overnight stay in Hotel.

DAY 07:

Jerusalem Old City - Via Dolorosa Golgotha

After breakfast, proceed to Jerusalem, we enter the Old City through St. Stephen's or Lion's Gate. Continue on foot to the church of Condemnation and Flagellation, where we begin the Via Dolorosa, the last five Stations of the Cross is situated inside the Holy Sepulcher. Also visiting Garden Tomb, the present route, and follow the footsteps of our Lord Jesus on his way to Calvary, culminating the journey to Golgotha. We will have Holy Communion at Garden Tomb. Dinner and Overnight stay in Hotel.

DAY 08:

Visit Last Supper Room, where we remember the Last Supper and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles on Pentecost. There after walk to the Dormition Abby and the traditional site of the Tomb of King David (visit

other Upper room). Ein Karem, one of the most beautiful settings near Jerusalem, located in the hills next to a little spring. Though a small Judean village, the area is important to Christian visitors because of the memory of a priest named Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth who lived in the area in: "a town in the hill country of Judea. Dinner and Overnight stay in Hotel.

DAY 09:

After breakfast proceed to Hebron is famous for its grapes, limestone, pottery workshops and Glassblowing factories. It is also the location of the major dairy product manufacturer, al-Juneidi. The old city of Hebron is haracterized by narrow, winding streets, flat- roofed stone houses, and old bazaars. The Cave of the Patriarchs is holy to all three Abrahamic faiths, Judaism, Christianity, and Islam, due to their traditional connections to Abraham. Visit Holocaust Museum Dinner and overnight stay at Bethlehem.

DAY 10:

Jerusalem Taba Breakfast at hotel. Check-out Hotel. Proceed to Taba. On the way View Qumran caves Inside View, view statue of Loth's wife & we shall drope by the RedSea for few minutes. Arrive Taba. Finish the Customs and Emigration formalities at the Israel side, Enter into Egypt. Complete the emigration and customs formalities. Overnught at Taba

After Breakfast proceed to Sinai. Visit St. Catherine Monastry. Set beneath the mountain where Moses is said to have received the Ten Commandments. Saint Catherine Monastery has been one of the world's great centers of religious pilgrimage for over fifteen centuries. Within its imposing walls rests, a citadel like no other, incredibly richin important religious and historical structures. Among its treasures is a library of ancient manuscripts and icons

second only to the Vatican's itself, and a 6th century church reputed to lie directly on the site of the Burning Bush. View the beautiful and historical Sinai Mountains. Proceed to Cairo, Check in to Hotel. Dinner & Overnight stay in Cairo.

DAY 11:

Visit Museum, Old Cairo, Christian Church After Breakfast, Visit Pharaonic Village/ Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo, Christian Church, Pyramids, Sphinx. However, it traditionally begins with the visit of the Holy Family to Egypt Papyrus Gallery - Perfume Factory, Pyramid, then 09 pm proceed to Cruising on the River Nile with Dinner Over night at Cairo....

DAY 12:

After breakfast proceed to airport for final departure.
