### **Day 1 - Amman, Jordan.**

Welcome to Amman, capital of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan. Arriving at Queen Alia Airport, meet & assist through all formalities, Dinner & overnight stay in Amman.

### **Day 2 - Petra, Moab, Pizga....**

After breakfast proceed to Madaba (the city of Mosaics) Mount Nebo, ten minutes west of Madaba, the final station in the life of the Prophet Moses, the Jordan valley and the hills of Jerusalem. Moses viewed the Promised Land that he would never enter. Visit Petra. (Numbers 20:15 – 21, 2 Chronicles 20, 1 Samuel 14:47, 2 Samuel 8:13-14). Overnight stay in Amman.

### **Day 3 - Nazareth**

After breakfast proceed to the Holy Land welcome by our guide at the border. Proceed to Nazareth Church of the Annunciation, Mary's House, and St. Joseph's workshop. Visit to Cana, where Jesus performed His first miracle of changing water into wine. Visit Nazareth Village. Overnight stay in Nazareth/Tiberius.

### **Day 4 - Capernaum, Tabgha, Galilee.....**

After breakfast visit Mount of Beatitude where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount, continue to Capernaum where we visit Jesus synagogue and the House of St. Peter. Proceed to the Primacy of Peter, where Jesus appeared to his disciples after the Resurrection and where he performed the miraculous catch of the 153 fish and conferred Church authority upon Peter, continue on to Tabgha, the traditional site of the multiplication of loaves and fish followed by a boat ride on the sea of Galilee. Proceed

to Mount Tabor and Neim. Overnight stay in Nazareth / Tiberius.

### **Day 5- Mt. Carmel, Haifa, Jaffa (Joppa), Tel Aviv, Jerusalem, Bethany, Western Wailing Wall.**

After breakfast visit includes Mt. Carmel, Muhrakka and Elijah's Cave, Haifa. We will be driving through Acre and visiting Ceseria. Drive along the coastal road to visit Old City of Jaffa (Joppa) and see the Church dedicated to St. Peter commemorating his miraculous healing of Tabita. Travel via Tel Aviv to Jerusalem. Visit Bethany, the house of Martha, Mary and Lazarus. We end the day with visit to the Western Wailing Wall considered to be the holiest site for the Jews. Overnight stay in hotel.

### **Day 6 - Mount of Olives, Gethsemane, Bethlehem, Jericho.....**

After breakfast visit Mount of Olives and visit Church of Ascension, the Church of Peter Noster, descend to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane, the traditional House of Caipas where Peter denied Jesus thrice and where Jesus was kept in the dungeon.

Proceed to Bethlehem the Shepherd's Field and Church of Nativity, the Birthplace of the Lord Jesus. Visit St. Jeromes Grotto where the Bible was translated from Hebrew. Then visit Jericho Temptation mount. Then proceed to Baptism site of Jesus at Jericho side, Jacobs Well, Shiloh, Beit El (Bethel). Dinner and overnight stay in hotel.

### **Day 7 - Jerusalem Old City, via Dolorosa, Golgotha, Garden Tomb.....**

After breakfast, proceed to Jerusalem, we enter the Old City through St. Stephen's or

Lion's Gate. Continue on foot to the Church of Condemnation and Flagellation, where we begin the Via Dolorosa, the last five stations of the Cross is situated inside the Holy Sepulcher. Also visiting Gaden Tomb. The present route and follow the footsteps of our Lord Jesus on his way to Calvary, culminating the journey to Golgotha. We will have Holy Communion at Garden Tomb. Visit Last Supper Room, where we remember the Last Supper and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles on Pentecost. There after walk to the Dormition Abby and the traditional site of the Tomb of King David (visit other Upper room). Ein Karem, one of the most beautiful settings near Jerusalem, located in the hills next to a little spring. Though a small Judean Village, the area is important to Christian visitors because of the memory of a priest named Zechariah and his wife Elizabeth who lived in the area in: "a town in the hill country of Judea". Dinner overnight stay at Bethlehem.

#### **Day 8 - Hebron, Bethlehem....**

After breakfast proceed to Hebron is famous for its grapes, limestone, pottery workshops and Glassblowing factories. It is also the location of the major dairy product manufacturer, Al-Juneidi. The old city of Hebron is Characterized by narrow, winding streets, flat-roofed stone houses, and old bazaars. The Cave of the Patriarchs is holy to all three Abrahamic faiths, Judaism, Christianiy and Islam, due to their traditional connections to Abraham. Dinner and overnight stay in Bethlehem.

#### **Day 9 - Jerusalem, Taba.....**

After breakfast check-out and proceed to Taba. On the way view Qumran Caves (outside view), view statue of Loth's wife &

we shall drop by the Red Sea for few minutes. Arrive Taba. Finish the Customs & Immigration formalities at the Israel side, enter into Egypt. Complete the emigration and customs formalities. Overnight at Taba / Sinai.

#### **Day 10 - Sinai, Cairo.....**

After breakfast, proceed to Sinai. Visit St. Catherine Monastery. Set beneath the mountain where Moses is said to have received the Ten Commandments. St. Catherine Monastery has been one of the world's great centers of religious pilgrimage for over fifteen centuries. Within its imposing wall rests a citadel like no other, incredibly rich in important religious and historical structures. Among its treasures is a library of ancient manuscripts and icons second only to the Vatican's itself, and a 6<sup>th</sup> century church reputed to lie directly on the site of the Burning Bush. View the beautiful and historical Sinai Mountains. Proceed to Cairo, check in to hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Cairo.

#### **Day 11 - Pharaonic Village / Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo....**

After breakfast, visit Pharaonic Village / Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo, Christian Church, Pyramids, Sphinx. However, it traditionally begins with the visit of the Holy Family to Egypt Papyrus Gallery, Perfume Factory, Pyramid. Then at 09.00pm, proceed to cruise on the River Nile with dinner. Overnight at Cairo.

#### **Day 12 – Return...**

After breakfast proceed to airport for final departure.

- Advance and Registration amount of US\$2500.00 per person (Registration amount of US\$500.00 is non-refundable) by cheque in favor of Admiral Travel Bureau L.L.C, Dallas, Texas along with valid Passport copy and duly signed registration form.
- Final payment by cheque or direct deposit 60days prior to the departure date.
- Single occupancy: Available upon request with extra payment.
- Booking of airline or hotels are subject to availability.
- Quoted tour price is applicable for the passengers from: DFW/IAH/ORD & JFK. Departure from other states / airports: Airline fare difference is applicable.
- Third party vendor deposits are not refundable.
- Passport should be valid for at least 6 months during the trip.

- Visa processing requires a minimum of 60 working days, however since this is a group departure, we would require all documents 75dys prior to the departure.

#### **Documents required:**

- Valid Passport (minimum validity of six months during travel) and three photographs as per the specifications of the Consulate or Embassy.

#### **Airlines:**

- The Admiral Travel Bureau L.L.C will not make seat selection in aircraft for group or individual passengers. If a guest needs seat arrangements in the aircraft, contact the airline directly.

#### **Payment:**

- Payment by cheque, bank deposit or bank transfer to the account of Admiral Travel Bureau L.L.C with JP Morgan Chase Bank. Bank details are available upon request.

#### **Cancellation and refund Policy – at any circumstances (including war, flood, strike or epidemic):**

- Cancellation up to 90 days prior to the departure date: Registration fee, applicable airline penalty charges and third-party vendor deposit will be deducted.
- Cancellation between 89-60 days prior to the departure date: 50% of the tour cost, airline cancellation penalty and third-party vendor deposit will be deducted.
