Heights of Europe

The "Heights of Europe" tour offers a scenic 8-day journey through Germany and Switzerland, starting in Munich and ending in Zurich. Highlights include city tours of Munich, Nuremberg, Frankfurt, and Lucerne; visits to historic sites like Dachau; and breathtaking alpine experiences at Zugspitze, Jungfrauoch, and Mt. Titlis. The trip also features Rhine River cruising, chocolate and cheese tasting, and immersive cultural encounters with expert English-speaking guides.

Day 1: Arrive at Munich Airport.

After all the immigration and customs formalities are over, meet our English-speaking Tour escort at the airport hall and guide you to the Coach. Proceed for full day Munich panoramic City Tour with English speaking guide covering the following must see attractions in Munich. (a) Marienplatz, (b) Cathedral of our Lady (Frauenkirche), (c)Victuals market (Viktualienmarket), (d) English Garden (Englischer Garten), (e) Munich Residence - (Residenz Munchen). 1200hrs – 1300hrs: Lunch break will be given... after lunch city orientation tour continues with guide for 2 hours. By 1600hrs transfer you to the hotel for an overnight stay. (International Check in Time is at 1400hrs and check-out time is at 1200hrs). Dinner at the hotel at 1930hrs and overnight stay in Holiday Inn Hotel, Munich or similar.

Day 2:

Continental breakfast starts at 0630 at the hotel. 0800hrs: proceed for your full day tour covering prominent summits of Germany through Zugspitze Cable Car (Start and destination – Zugspitzbahn station Garmisch – Partenkirchen), Duration: 3-4 hours and early arrival recommended. Your full-time English-speaking escort will be with you throughout the day. Highlights of the tour: (a) Tradition meet

modernity: Rides on the nostalgic cogwheel train, the Gletscherbahn cable car and the modern cable car Zugspitze. (b) Visit the Zugspitze polateau right by the glacier. (c) 360-degree views from the summit of Germany’s highest mountain. (d) Scenic views of 400 surrounding mountain peaks. Lunch break: 1230-1300hrs. Tour continue after lunch. 1700hrs: return to Munich hotel. 1930hrs: Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay in the Holiday Inn Hotel, Munich or similar.

Day 3:

After the continental breakfast starts at 0630hrs: After the continental breakfast, today you check out the hotel and proceed for your tour to Dachau at 0800hrs. Munich to Dachau distance: 45miles - 1hr 10 minutes. Your full-time English-speaking escort will be with you throughout the day. English speaking guide will meet you at Dachau for duration of 2hours.

In the spring of 1933, the first Nazi concentration camp in Germany was opened northeast of Dachau, initially planned to hold political prisoners, it soon became a model for all other concentration camps. It also served as training center for the SS: the “school of violence”. This tour takes you from the center of Munich to the historic memorial of the Dachau Concentration camp, with specially trained guides, you explore a monument to one of the history’s cruelest crimes. You will get a chance to see Original former gas chambers, Crematorium, Prisoner barracks, Nanogold monument. Lunch break: 1230 – 1330hrs. After Lunch proceed to Nuremberg. Dachau to Nuremberg distance: 2hrs,15minutes (190km). Proceed to Nuremberg at 1330hr. On arrival at Nuremberg meet our English-speaking guide for 2.00hrs for our guided tour. Discover a truly extraordinary place Nuremberg, a beautiful and prosperous medieval walled city, a center of the Holy Roman Empire, a cradle of the German Renaissance, temple city of the Third Reich, and the home of both the Nuremberg Nazi rallies and Nuremberg trials. Our Guide show you where German Emperors were crowned, where saints are buried,

where the most famous and talented German Artisans in history created awe-inspiring works and where the colorful and lively markets have taken place for almost 700 years. We explore the enchanting old town if time permits.... With its fantastic regional food and drink, and the greatest Christmas markets in Germany (Christmas markets are in December, but Christmas shopping is available year-round). We will head out to the Nazi Rally grounds, the largest Third Reich ruins in the world. Come explore the city of Empires on an unforgettable walking tour... and thereafter proceed to Frankfurt hotel at 1600hrs. Distance to Frankfurt hotel from Nuremberg: 2 hrs, 46 minutes (225km). After the check-in formalities are over at the hotel – Dinner at 1930hrs at the hotel. Overnight stay at Movenpick Hotel, Frankfurt or similar.

Day 4:

Breakfast at 06:30am & departure at 08:00am. Frankfurt to Boppard distance: 1 hr, 44 mins (127 km). After the Continental breakfast at the hotel (breakfast starts from 0630 am onwards). A tour escort will be with you throughout the day. Today you are supposed to leave early as we are proceeding to explore Sankt Goar, is a town located in the Rhein-lahn-Kreis in Nassau on the eastern shore of the Rhine. It lies approximately 30 km south of Koblenz, and it is above all famous for the Lorelei rock nearby. The town's economy is based on wine making and tourism. Explore the city on your own. Later, explore sailing the Romantic Boppard Rhine River ferry. The old town, vineyards, and Lorelei Rock are worth the short cruise. A savvy traveler should have a cruise on the Rhine as an absolute must for a bucket list. A tour and cruise along the beautiful Rhine is the one way to understand and match up present and past times in lovely Deutschland. 1300hrs the lunch break, tour continues and by 1600hrs return to Frankfurt hotel. Dinner will be served at 1930hrs and Overnight stay at Movenpick Hotel, Frankfurt or similar.

Day 5:

Breakfast at 06:30am. Get your luggage ready in the lobby. Departure for city Tour at 08:00hrs

Frankfurt – Zurich distance: 4 hrs., 34minuts (409 km) by road. After breakfast at the hotel, check out the hotel. Your Tour escort will be with you throughout the day. Proceed for half day city tour with English speaking guide for 2 hours covering all the main landmarks in Frankfurt. You will get free last-minute shopping (if time permits) for souvenirs and gifts for your loved ones. Lunch break at 1200hrs. Thereafter get ready for a long journey to Zurich exploring the magnificent remaining natural beauty of Germany and Switzerland. Arrives Zurich Hotel – Checking formalities are over at the hotel.... Dinner will be served at the hotel itself at 1930hrs. Overnight stay in Movenpick hotel, Zurich or similar.

Day 6:

After the continental breakfast at the hotel (breakfast starts at 0630am). Your Tour escort will be with you throughout the day. Today you are going to explore the land of Chocolate and Cheese and Land of Top of Europe, through Eiger Express + Rack Rail Grund – Jungfrau – Grund. Mount Jungfrau with 11,362 ft above sea level. The Jungfraujoch is a glacier saddle, on the upper snows of the Aletsch Glacier. The Jungfraujoch is the highest accessible railway in Europe. The best shoulder season to visit Top of Europe is during April and May to avoid the crowds. Grindelwald, Lauterbrunnen, Murren and Wengen are the places located in the Jungfrau region and are 30 minutes of Interlaken and orientation tour in Interlaken with the Tour Escort. Lunch break from 13:00hrs to 14.:00hrs. Proceed to Interlaken, is a traditional resort town in the mountainous Bernese Oberland region of Central Switzerland. Built on a narrow stretch of valley, between the emerald-colored waters of lake Thun and Lake Brienz, it has an old timber house, its surrounding mountains, with dense forests, alpine meadows and glaciers, has numerous hiking and skiing trails and must explore site in Switzerland. Return to

Zurich...at 1600hrs. Dinner will be served at the hotel at 1930hrs. Overnight stay at Movenpick Hotel, Zurich or similar.

Day 7:

After the continental breakfast at the hotel (breakfast starts at 0630am), your Tour escort will be with you throughout the day, and you depart after breakfast to explore one of the beautiful places on earth, Engelberg, trails weave up Mt. Titlis and ski runs zigzag down, while revolving Titlis Rotair gondola lift leads us to summit. Titlis Cliff Walk suspension bridge, and a glacial park, Trubsee, a glacial lake lies nearby to explore. Mount Titlis is known for the world's first revolving cable car. Lunch between 12:30hrs – 13:30hrs on top of Mt. Titlis and thereafter proceed to Lucerne for an orientation tour with Tour escort, another Romantic city in Europe called Lucerne.

Lucerne, a compact city in Switzerland known for its preserved medieval architecture, sits amidst

snowcapped mountains on lake Lucerne. Its colorful Altstadt (Old Town) is bordered on the north by 870m Museggmauer, a 14-century rampart. The covered Kapel Brücke (Chapel Bridge), built in 1333, links the Altstadt to the Reuss River right bank. Enjoy Lake Lucerne Cruise experience for an hour and free time for shopping elegant Swiss watches and chocolates. Later return to Zurich at 1630hrs. Dinner will be served at the hotel at 1930hrs. Overnight stay at Movenpick Hotel, Zurich or similar.

Day 8:

Return to USA, transfer to Zurich airport)

After continental breakfast at the hotel and check out the hotel and transfer you to Swiss airport, Zurich for your onward journey to United States of America with wonderful memories to cherish in your entire lifetime.

- Final payment by cheque or direct deposit 60days prior to the departure date.
- Single occupancy: Available upon request with extra payment.
- Booking of hotels are subject to availability.
- Third party vendor deposits are not refundable.
- Passport should be valid for at least 6 months during the trip.
- The rates are subject to change in case of surcharge or high season or conventions periods.
- Hotel check-in time is subject to vary as per the local rules of each country.

- Some hotels will not provide Iron & Ironing board in the room, but available on request or common place with iron and ironing board.
- Some restaurants will provide vegetarian food with fish.
- As a third person in a triple room, the third person will get a rollaway bed. The room size may be the same as a double room.
- A person under 11 years is considered as child and infant sharing parent's bed.

Visa Processing (If required):

- Visa processing requires a minimum of 60 working days, however since this is a group departure, we would require all documents 75dys prior to the departure.

Documents required:

- Valid Passport (minimum validity of six months during travel) and three photographs as per the specifications of the Consulate or Embassy.

Airlines:

- The Admiral Travel Bureau will not make seat selection in aircraft for group or individual passengers. If a guest needs seat arrangements in the aircraft, contact the airline directly.

Payment:

- Payment by cheque, bank deposit or bank transfer to the account of Admiral Travel Bureau with JP Morgan Chase Bank. Bank details are available upon request.

Cancellation and refund Policy – at any circumstances (including war, flood, strike or epidemic)

- Cancellation up to 90 days prior to the departure date: Registration fee, applicable airline penalty charges and third-party vendor deposit will be deducted.
- Cancellation between 89-60 days prior to the departure date: 50% of the tour cost, airline cancellation penalty and third-party vendor deposit will be deducted.
- Cancellation between 59-31 days prior to the departure date: 75% of the total tour cost, airline cancellation penalty and third-party vendor deposit will be deducted.
- Cancellation on 30 days or less prior to the departure date: NO SHOW' on the tour: 100% of the total tour cost, any airline penalty will be deducted.
- A refund will be made after 60 days of the scheduled departure of the tour subject to the funds available from the tour operator from foreign countries.
